3 WHEREAS, the responsibilities of the transportation, economy and environment
4 committee for 2015 are detailed in Motion 14324 unless a new motion is passed, and

5 WHEREAS, Motion 14324 charges the transportation, economy and environment
6 committee with considering and making policy recommendations relating to:

7 1. Growth management, including land use development and regulation,
8 comprehensive planning, including implementation of its affordable housing elements,
9 economic development, including pay equity and income disparity, and annexations;

10 2. The environment, including: salmon recovery; resource lands; energy; surface
11 water management and water supply; wastewater treatment; solid waste; and
12 unincorporated and rural areas, including agriculture and rural services; and parks,
13 recreation and cultural resources; and

14 3. Transportation, including roads, passenger ferries and public transportation,
15 and

16 WHEREAS, the committee shall also consider the implementation of appropriate
17 labor agreements, and

18 WHEREAS, in the areas within the committee's purview, the committee shall
19 track state and federal legislative action and develop recommendations on policy
20 direction for the biennial budget, and

21 WHEREAS, the committee has developed a work plan for 2015 to facilitate its
22 review and development of policy options and recommendations on these and other
23 issues, and

24 WHEREAS, the committee seeks full council support for its work plan;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
