1 A MOTION appointing committees to write a voters
2 pamphlet statement for the November 3, 2015 special
3 election regarding Ordinance 18088 providing for the
4 submission to the electorate of King County, at a special
5 election on November 3, 2015, of a proposition
6 authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the levy
7 limitations contained in chapter 84.55 RCW for a
8 consecutive six-year period at a first year rate of not more
9 than 14 cents per one thousand dollars of assessed
10 valuation, and limiting annual levy increases to three
11 percent in the five succeeding years, all for the purpose of
12 funding prevention and early intervention strategies to
13 improve the health and well-being of children, youth and
14 their communities.

15 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of
16 local voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of chapter 29A.32 RCW for
17 annual general elections held in King County, and

18 WHEREAS 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is
19 included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall

20 formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the
21 measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure,
22 and

23 WHEREAS Ordinance 18088 provides for submission to the voters on November
24 3, 2015, of a proposed property tax levy for the purpose of funding prevention and early
25 intervention strategies to improve the health and well-being of children, youth and their
26 communities;
