1	A MOTION in support of a statewide and national ban on
2	nontherapeutic uses of antibiotics in livestock production.
3	WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimate that 23,000
4	people die from antibiotic-resistant infections each year, and
5	WHEREAS, antibiotics have been used for the last seventy years to treat people
6	with infections, are effective against bacteria and are among the most-commonly
7	prescribed drugs used in human medicine, and
8	WHEREAS, antibiotics have been used so widely and for so long that the
9	infectious organisms that the antibiotics are designed to kill have adapted to a growing
10	number of them, making the drugs ineffective or less effective, and
11	WHEREAS, as antibiotic resistance increases, physicians have fewer effective
12	drugs to treat patients, and
13	WHEREAS, scientists have provided strong evidence that antibiotic use in food
14	animals can lead to drug-resistant infections in humans, and
15	WHEREAS, any overuse or misuse of antibiotics, whether in human medicine or
16	in agriculture, contributes to the spread of antibiotic resistance, and
17	WHEREAS, eighty percent of the antibiotics sold in the United States are used in
18	livestock production. When animals are given antibiotics for growth promotion, to
19	increase feed efficiency or to routinely prevent disease in unhealthy conditions, this

nontherapeutic low-level exposure to antibiotics may be particularly conducive to the 20 21 survival and growth of drug resistant bacteria, and WHEREAS, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration is currently working with 22 drug makers to implement a voluntary policy to eliminate approved growth-promoting 23 24 uses in food animals of those antibiotics that are used in human medicine and to improve 25 veterinary oversight of all in-feed and water uses of those drugs, and WHEREAS, antibiotics should be used appropriately based on the best available 26 evidence and taking into account public health and the need to prevent emergence of 27 28 resistance, and WHEREAS, at the local level, the city of Seattle in 2014 passed a resolution 29 supporting a statewide and national ban on nontherapeutic uses of antibiotics in livestock 30 production, and 31 WHEREAS, at the national level, the Chipotle Mexican Grill restaurant chain 32 serves antibiotic-free meat, and major buyers of chicken such as McDonald's and Costco 33 have recently announced commitments to phasing out purchase of chicken raised with 34 antibiotics that are important to human medicine; 35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: 36

King County supports a statewide and national ban on nontherapeutic uses of antibiotics in livestock production.
