	Proposed No. 2017-0418.2 Sponsors Balducci
1	A MOTION requiring the executive to report on options for
2	enhancing mobility in areas of the county that have high
3	concentrations of people with disabilities.
4	WHEREAS, Center Park is a one-hundred-thirty-seven-unit low-income public
5	housing facility located at 2121 - 26th Avenue South, Seattle, that is owned and operated
6	by the Seattle Housing Authority and that serves a high proportion of residents with
7	disabilities, and
8	WHEREAS, King County has provided customized transit service to residents of
9	Center Park since the 1970s, originally providing this service because Center Park was
10	the central location for Seattle Housing Authority to house most or all residents with
11	disabilities; and
12	WHEREAS, the housing distribution for individuals with disabilities in public
13	housing has changed significantly;
14	WHEREAS, the King County council has required that customized transit service
15	provided to residents of Center Park to continue to be provided during the hours that were
16	in effect as of September 1, 2017, using Metro Transit vehicles appropriate for the
17	operating conditions, and that this schedule shall remain in effect until the effective date
18	of the September 2018 service change unless another service schedule is approved by the
19	council by ordinance, and

20	WHEREAS, King County is currently engaged in an evaluation of King County's
21	Access paratransit service that is provided for people with disabilities who are unable to
22	use regular, fixed-route transit services, as part of an effort to make the paratransit service
23	more effective, efficient and responsive to the needs of its users, and
24	WHEREAS, the King County council wishes to ensure that people with
25	disabilities throughout King County, particularly in locations of the county that have
26	similar numbers and concentrations of people with disabilities as live at Center Park, both
27	those who use regular, fixed-route transit services and those who use paratransit services
28	have transit options available to enhance their mobility;
29	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
30	A. The executive shall submit a report and a motion that approves the report on
31	all areas of the county that have similar numbers and concentrations of people with
32	disabilities as live at Center Park, together with options for enhancing mobility for these
33	individuals.
34	B. The report shall include, but not be limited to:
35	1. Data on areas of the county that are comparable to Center Park in the number
36	of residents with disabilities;
37	2. Options for improving mobility for the residents of these locations, including
38	but not limited to improved fixed route transit service, Community Connections or
39	alternative services, the Community Access Transportation program and Access
40	paratransit service for those eligible; and
41	3. A synopsis of how implementing the options identified in subsection B.2. of
42	this section aligns with current efforts to improve fixed route service accessibility

- implement the Community Connections program and improve Access paratransit serviceimplementation.
- C. The executive should file the report and a motion required by this section by February 28, 2018, in the form of a paper original and an electronic copy with the clerk
- of the council, who shall retain the original and provide an electronic copy to all

- 48 councilmembers, the council chief of staff, the chief policy officer and the lead staff for
- 49 the transportation, economy and environment committee, or its successor.
