1 A MOTION appointing committees to write the voters'
2 pamphlet statements for the November 5, 2019, election
3 regarding Ordinance 18931 providing for the submission to
4 the qualified electors of King County, at special election on
5 November 5, 2019, of a proposition to continue funding for
6 the countywide Medic One emergency medical services
7 system by authorizing a regular property tax levy for a
8 consecutive six year period, for collection beginning in
9 2020, at a rate of \$0.265 or less per \$1,000 of assessed
10 valuation, to provide for Medic One emergency medical
11 services.

12 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of
13 local voters' pamphlets in conformity with chapter 29A.32 RCW for annual general
14 elections held in King County, and

15 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that, for each measure from a unit of
16 local government that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of
17 that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating
18 voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter
19 rejection of the measure, and

20 WHEREAS, Ordinance 18931 provides for the submission to the qualified
21 electors of King County, at special election to be held in King County on November 5,
22 2019, of a proposition to continue funding for the countywide Medic One emergency
23 medical services system by authorizing a regular property tax levy for a consecutive six
24 year period, for collection beginning in 2020, at a rate of \$0.265 or less per \$1,000 of
25 assessed valuation, to provide for Medic One emergency medical services;

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

27 The following individuals are appointed to serve on the voters' pamphlet
28 committees, with each committee to write a statement for or against the countywide
29 Medic One emergency medical services renewal levy proposal placed on the ballot by
30 Ordinance 18931 for the November 5, 2019, election:
