2 pamphlet statement for the November 3, 2020, general

3 election regarding Ordinance 19117 providing for the

4 submission to the qualified electors of King County, at a

5 special election to be held in conjunction with the general

6 election on November 3, 2020, of a proposition authorizing

7 the county to issue its general obligation bonds in the

8 aggregate principal amount of not to exceed

9 \$1,740,000,000 or so much thereof as may be issued under

10 the laws governing the indebtedness of counties, for the

11 purpose of providing funds to public health, safety and

12 seismic improvements for Harborview Medical Center.

13 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of

14 local voters' pamphlets in conformity with chapter 29A.32 RCW for elections held in

15 King County, and

16 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction

17 that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction

18 shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the

19 measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure,

21 WHEREAS, Ordinance 19117 provides for the submission to the qualified
22 electors of King County, at a special election to be held in conjunction with the general
23 election on November 3, 2020, of a proposition authorizing the county to issue its general
24 obligation bonds in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$1,740,000,000 or so
25 much thereof as may be issued under the laws governing the indebtedness of counties, for
26 the purpose of providing funds to pay for public health, safety and seismic improvements
27 for Harborview Medical Center;
