1 A MOTION requesting the executive to contract with the
2 University of Washington to conduct a retrospective
3 analysis of the impacts of COVID-19 and the actions taken
4 by King County leaders and public health - Seattle & King
5 County to limit the spread of the virus.

6 WHEREAS, the novel coronavirus first appeared in people in Wuhan, China, in
7 December 2019, and

8 WHEREAS, the first confirmed case of COVID-19 identified in the United States
9 occurred in January in a Snohomish County resident who had traveled to China, and

10 WHEREAS, public health - Seattle & King County activated the Public Health
11 Departmental Emergency Operations Center on January 21, 2020, for a significant health
12 emergency caused by novel coronavirus, and

13 WHEREAS, the King County executive issued a proclamation of emergency on
14 March 1, 2020, in order to exercise the executive's emergency powers, and

15 WHEREAS, Washington Governor Jay Inslee issued Proclamation 20-25 on
16 March 23, 2020 imposing a Stay Home - Stay Healthy Order throughout Washington
17 State, and

18 WHEREAS, as of April 26, 2020, there have been 5,912 positive cases and 407
19 deaths in King County, and

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20 WHEREAS, in Washington, public health - Seattle & King County and local
21 institutions such as the University of Washington, including the Medical Center and
22 Institute for Health Metrics and Evaluation, and the Gates Foundation have been at the
23 forefront of the pandemic since it emerged in the United States in January 2020, and

24 WHEREAS, a retrospective analysis of the COVID-19 response in King County
25 could provide decision makers in local government, the healthcare field and the
26 community with valuable information to respond to future pandemics;

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

28 A. The executive is requested to contract with the Evans School of Public Policy
29 and Governance at the University of Washington to conduct an independent retrospective
30 analysis to include, but not be limited to, the health, economic and social impacts of
31 COVID-19 and the actions taken by King County leaders and public health - Seattle &
32 King County to respond to the pandemic and limit the spread of the virus. During
33 contract negotiations, the executive may negotiate access to public health and executive
34 branch leaders in order to prioritize the ongoing pandemic response. The study should be
35 conducted by graduate students using publicly available data and resources and
36 commence in January 2021.

37 B. The executive is requested to submit a report based on the retrospective
38 analysis to the council. The report should be filed by July 31, 2021, in the form of a
39 paper original and an electronic copy with the executive and clerk of the council, who

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40 shall retain the original and provide an electronic copy to all councilmembers, the chief
41 of staff and the chief policy officer.

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
