1	A MOTION reaffirming the King County council's support		
2	of unbanked money transfer operators and the immigrant		
3	communities they serve.		
4	WHEREAS, money transfer operators ("MTOs") in King County, and across the		
5	United States, have been unable to secure bank accounts due to a process referred to as		
6	"bank derisking," and		
7	WHEREAS, a recent string of armed robberies on those unbanked MTOs in		
8	SeaTac, Seattle and surrounding cities has turned the issue into a public safety concern,		
9	and		
10	WHEREAS, East African immigrant communities in King County rely on those		
11	MTOs to send money to their loved ones abroad. Funding from remittances accounts for		
12	basic needs including food, water, shelter and education, and		
13	WHEREAS, over the past few years, those MTOs have found it increasingly		
14	difficult to operate without bank accounts. Many have shut down, and the ones that		
15	remain transport millions of dollars in cash through SeaTac Airport each month, and		
16	WHEREAS, those MTOs: provide culturally specific services; deliver money to		
17	remote regions not served by the large operators, including refugee camps in East Africa;		
18	provide good paying jobs; contribute to community activities; and are a valuable		
19	members of King County's small-business community, and		

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20	WHEREAS, King County has one of the largest African communities in the		
21	United States; nearly 51,000 people from sub-Saharan Africa are residents in King		
22	County, and		
23	WHEREAS, the vast majority of our East African residents are refugees and our		
24	new residents need effective systems that will support them in staying connected to their		
25	loved ones back home, and		
26	WHEREAS, East Africans are critical to King County's economic vitality because		
27	they purchase goods and services and run small businesses, which in turn create jobs and		
28	generate revenue for the region, and		
29	WHEREAS, Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals participants and religious		
30	institutions, such as mosques, also struggle to secure reliable banking services, and		
31	WHEREAS, it is in King County's interest to promote financial inclusion and		
32	public safety, and		
33	WHEREAS, the state of Washington has jurisdiction over state-licensed banks,		
34	and		
35	WHEREAS, the state of Washington has the authority to pass laws and develop		
36	processes that promote financial inclusion and public safety;		
37	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:		
38	A. The council reaffirms its support of our East African community in their		
39	desires to support their loved ones, and also reaffirms the right of MTOs to engage in		
40	lawful commerce in a safe manner.		
41	B. The council calls on the Washington state Senate Financial Institutions,		
42	Economic Development and Trade Committee and the Washington state House of		

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- 43 Representatives Consumer Protection and Business Committee to study the issue of bank
- 44 derisking and to find a solution that promotes financial inclusion and public safety for
- 45 immigrant communities throughout the state.
- 46 C. The council directs its government relations team to reach out to the state of

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- 47 Washington and the Washington state Legislature to explore actions they can take to
- 48 promote financial inclusion for King County residents and businesses.
