1 A MOTION appointing committees to write a voters'
2 pamphlet statement for the November 8, 2022, general
3 election regarding Ordinance 19458 providing for the
4 submission to the qualified electors of King County at the
5 general election to be held in King County on November 8,
6 2022, of a proposition to restore King County's
7 conservation futures property tax levy authorized under
8 RCW 84.34.230 to a rate of \$0.0625 per one thousand
9 dollars of assessed valuation for collection in 2023 and use
10 the dollar amount of the 2023 levy for the purpose of
11 computing limitations for subsequent levies under chapter
12 84.55 RCW to provide funding for conservation futures as
13 permitted under chapter 84.34 RCW, including, but not
14 limited to, to pay, finance and refinance costs of the
15 acquisition and preservation, of: urban green spaces,
16 natural areas, wildlife and salmon habitat, trails, river
17 corridors, farmlands and forests; and providing for
18 conservation futures advisory committee recommendations.

19 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of
20 local voters' pamphlets in conformity with chapter 29A.32 RCW for elections held in
21 King County, and

22 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 requires that for each measure from a jurisdiction
23 that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction
24 formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the
25 measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure,
26 and

27 WHEREAS, Ordinance 19458 provides for the submission to the qualified
28 electors of King County at the general election to be held in King County on November
29 8, 2022, of a proposition to restore King County's conservation futures property tax levy
30 authorized under RCW 84.34.230 to a rate of \$0.0625 per one thousand dollars of
31 assessed valuation for collection in 2023 and to use the dollar amount of the 2023 levy
32 for the purpose of computing limitations for subsequent levies under chapter 84.55 RCW
33 to provide funding for conservation futures as permitted under chapter 84.34 RCW,
34 including, but not limited to, to pay, finance and refinance costs of the acquisition and
35 preservation, of: urban green spaces, natural areas, wildlife and salmon habitat, trails,
36 river corridors, farmlands and forests; and provides for conservation futures advisory
37 committee recommendations;




