1 A MOTION related to the transfer of retired vanpool vans
 2 to nonprofit organizations and local governments to meet
 3 the needs of low-income, seniors or young people or people
 4 with disabilities.

5 WHEREAS, King County provides transit services to its residents to increase
 6 mobility options and reduce traffic congestion and related environmental degradation,
 7 and

8 WHEREAS, the provision of passenger vans to nonprofit organizations and local
 9 governments serving individuals with limited resources and mobility options can support
 10 those goals and provide significant public benefits, and

11 WHEREAS, high-quality passenger vans retaining value and utility are
 12 periodically retired from the county's vanpool program, and

13 WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council has previously transferred
 14 retired vans to agencies serving low-income, seniors, or young people, or people with
 15 disabilities, and

16 WHEREAS, K.C.C. 4.56.100 states that, "the Metro transit department shall make
 17 available retired passenger vans for exclusive use by nonprofit organizations or local
 18 governments that are able to address the mobility needs of low-income, seniors or young
 19 people or people with disabilities," and

20 WHEREAS, K.C.C. 4.56.100 states that nonprofit organizations or local

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21 governments that are allocated a van must use the van to transport low-income, seniors or
22 young people or people with disabilities or to transport goods or supplies, including, but
23 not limited to, food, clothing, school supplies or medical equipment, to serve the needs of
24 low-income, seniors or young people or people with disabilities;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

26 The transfer of a retired vanpool passenger van to each of the following agencies
27 is hereby approved:

28 Friends of Youth;

29 Institute for Community Leadership;

30 Issaquah Food & Clothing Bank;

31 North Helpline;

32 Phinney Neighborhood Association (for the Greenwood Senior Center);

33 Riverton Park United Methodist Church;

34 Tahoma School District;


