12                   WHEREAS, in accordance with K.C.C. 2.53.021, appointments to the citizens'  
13 elections oversight committee are subject to confirmation by the full council by motion,  
14 and

15                   WHEREAS, on November 5, 2024, in accordance with K.C.C. 2.53.021, the  
16 employment and administration committee reappointed Tyson Hartman to the citizens'  
17 elections oversight committee for a three-year term to expire on July 31, 2027;


