1 A MOTION requesting the executive provide a county
2 response to support the people affected by fires in the
3 greater Los Angeles area.

4 WHEREAS multiple fires began the week of January 7, 2025, in the greater Los
5 Angeles area and spread rapidly due to exceptionally dry conditions and hurricane force
6 winds, and

7 WHEREAS those fires caused the deaths of at least 24 people and the forced
8 evacuation of at least 150,000 people, and

9 WHEREAS the fires have burned more than 38,000 acres and destroyed an
10 estimated 10,000 buildings, with estimates of economic loss as high as \$150 billion, in
11 what Los Angeles Fire Department Chief Kristin Crowley has called "one of the most
12 destructive natural disasters in the history of Los Angeles," and

13 WHEREAS the disaster has already adversely impacted housing security and
14 housing costs for the people in the region and will exacerbate the region's existing
15 housing crisis, and

16 WHEREAS the council has a history of requesting the executive provide a county
17 response to support the people of other countries that are impacted by disasters such as
18 Motion 16209, passed in September 2022, to respond to severe flooding in Pakistan,
19 Motion 16108, passed in April 2022, to respond to the crisis in Ukraine, and Motion

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20 15518, passed in September 2019, to provide relief for the people of the Bahamas who
21 were impacted by Hurricane Dorian;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

23 The executive is requested to provide a county response to support the people
24 affected by the fires in the Los Angeles area. The response plan should include, but not
25 be limited to, the following:

26 A. Consulting with, collaborating with, and providing support to local nonprofit
27 organizations that have established ties to the people of Los Angeles and that are already
28 providing support to the relief efforts;

29 B. Leveraging the employee giving program established under K.C.C. 3.36.030,
30 leave for volunteer service policy established under K.C.C. 3.12.225, and donation of
31 vacation or compensatory hours to nonprofit organizations policy established under
32 K.C.C. 3.12.222, to provide opportunities for county employees to support the relief
33 efforts. The executive should develop ways to streamline the use of these programs to
34 ensure support is delivered quickly and efficiently with minimal administrative burden;

35 C. Donating any county surplus resources such as medical supplies, hygiene
36 products, and emergency supply kits;

37 D. Offering technical expertise from county personnel, particularly from
38 employees in the office of emergency management and the department of natural
39 resources and parks;

40 E. Collaborating with federal, state, and local governments that have committed
41 to providing support to the people of Los Angeles to ensure support is delivered quickly
42 and efficiently with minimal administrative burden; and

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43 F. Offering technical expertise and other support on policies that provide
44 increased housing supply, renters' protections, and labor protections as the region
45 recovers from the disaster.
