

MOTION NO.

WHEREAS, King County, Washington, recognizes the need for county-wide solid waste management planning, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Washington has provided for a program to fund comprehensive solid waste management planning (Chapter 134, 41st Legislature, 1st Extraordinary Session), and

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology is the Agency of the State of Washington responsible for the allocation and administration of financial aid to counties and cities for the preparation of comprehensive county plans for solid waste management, and

WHEREAS, King County has applied to the Department of Ecology for financial aid for the preparation of such a plan and said Department has approved the granting of an award of financial assistance to King County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

1. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute such contracts as are required by the Department of Ecology pursuant to RCW 70.95.150.

2. That the County Executive is hereby directed to establish the necessary coordinating mechanism to assure the accomplishment of program goals set forth in Chapter 134, 41st Legislature, 1st Extraordinary Session.
