

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to  
2 execute and submit a grant application to the  
3 State Law & Justice Planning Office for funds  
4 in the amount of \$33,576 to establish the  
5 position of District Court Administrator.

6 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of  
7 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law  
8 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of  
9 Justice, through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning  
10 Office, and;

11 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need among the  
12 District Courts of King County to relieve the judges of non-  
13 judicial tasks, and to consolidate District Court operations,  
14 especially in the areas of budgeting, personnel administration  
15 and purchasing; and,

16 WHEREAS, this grant would provide the means to coordinate  
17 the activities of the twelve courts, and relieve District Court  
18 Judges of these non-judicial burdens;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized  
21 to make application for funds in the amount of \$33,576 to the  
22 State Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

23 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and  
24 directed to file and execute such application and contracts  
25 as are required by the State;

26 3. That the King County Law & Justice Planning Office  
27 is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is  
28 further authorized to furnish such additional information and  
29 documents as may be required by the State;

30 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter  
31 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the  
32 implementation of the project.

1           5.    That the United States of America, Department of  
2 Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full  
3 compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
