MOTION NO. 1192

A MOTION expressing King County's willingness to apply to HEW as a Head Start grantee.

WHEREAS, Head Start is a program designed to identify and alleviate developmental disabilities of disadvantaged pre-schoolers through programs which provide for strengthening and supporting the family unit and children in their essential care and development of physical, social, emotional and educational skills.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The uninterrupted continuance of the Head Start program is of paramount importance to King County, and

The King County Council encourages HEW to consider a Community Action Group to serve as a grantee for Head Start; and

BE IT FURTHER MOVED:

In the event that a Community Action Group is not selected:

(1) King County expresses its willingness to become the Head Start grantee which is conditional and subject to the satisfactory resolution of certain HEW guideline provisions in order that compatibility with the King County Charter is assured; and

(2) King County will work for assurance that the HEAD START program is community controlled.

(3) King County intends to follow HEW guidelines for applying to HEW as a HEAD START grantee.

2 King County either to act as joint grantee with the City of  
3 Seattle or to operate a joint program with Seattle.
