A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the State Law and Justice Planning Office for funds in the amount of \$42,654 to Sponsor the Operation of a Basic Skills Education Program for Inmates at Seattle Central Community College, PS-347

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and

WHEREAS, King County supports the effort of the Seattle Central Community College to provide inmates of the County and City of Seattle jails with the basic tools of education and is willing to act as sponsor on behalf of the College to the State Law and Justice Planning Office, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle Central Community College recognizes its obligation to provide as support to this program approximately \$9,682 as an in-kind match and \$6,999 as a cash match to be appropriated by the County if funding is approved by the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$42,654 to the State Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;
