1 A MOTION Authorizing the County Executive to  
2 Execute and submit a grant Application to the  
3 Washington State Employment Security Depart-  
ment for Funds in the Amount of \$2,880 to Sup-  
port the Bellevue Job Line Project.

4 WHEREAS, The Washington State Employment Security Depart-  
5 ment is empowered to enter into contracts on behalf of the King-  
6 Snohomish Manpower Consortium, and

7 WHEREAS, The King-Snohomish Manpower Consortium provides  
8 funds to support Comprehensive Manpower Program intake services,  
9 and

10 WHEREAS, The Bellevue Job Line Project is capable of pro-  
11 viding these services, and

12 WHEREAS, The County Council recognizes the need to in-  
13 crease delivery of Comprehensive Manpower services to residents of  
14 the area of King County east of Lake Washington, and

15 WHEREAS, The County recognizes its obligation to provide  
16 as support to this program \$2,880 as a Cash Match,

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

18 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to  
19 make application for funds in the amount of \$2,880 to the Washing-  
20 ton State Employment Security Department on behalf of King County;

21 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and dir-  
22 ected to file and execute such application and contracts as are re-  
23 quired by the State;

24 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named the  
25 authorized correspondent for King County, and is further authorized  
26 to furnish such additional information and documents as may be re-  
27 quired by the State;


1           4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter
