

MOTION NO. 2316

1 A MOTION relating to the 1976 Mental
2 Health Plan of King County; modifying
3 the plan; increasing the fiscal allocation
4 to the Seattle Counseling Service.

5 WHEREAS, W.A.C. regulation 275-12-136 specifies that an
6 agency has the right to appeal to the King County Council when
7 it is dissatisfied with a funding decision made by the King
8 County Mental Health Administrative Board, and

9 WHEREAS, Seattle Counseling Service for Sexual Minorities
10 has appealed the decision of the Mental Health Board with
11 regard to the agency's funding for 1975 and 1976, and

12 WHEREAS, the Council's Health and Human Service Committee
13 held a prolonged public hearing beginning January 28, 1976,
14 which was concluded February 10, 1976

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


16 Council staff is directed to insure that the 1976 Mental
17 Health Plan of King County reflect a deduction of \$6,805.00
18 from the present proposed contingency fund and that a similar
19 amount be clearly reflected as an allocation for contracted
20 service with the Seattle Counseling Service program; PROVIDED
21 THAT, the Council clearly recognizes that should contingencies
22 arise in the County's Mental Health program, it shall make
23 every effort to replace deducted monies to the contingency
24 fund.
