A MOTION approving the reclassification petitioned by WEYERHAEUSER REAL ESTATE COMPANY, designated Building and Land Development File No. 201-76-R and modifying conditions of approval recommended by the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner.

WHEREAS, the reclassification petitioned by WEYERHAEUSER REAL ESTATE COMPANY, designated Building and Land Development File No. 201-76-R was approved by the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner subject to conditions; and

WHEREAS, the WEYERHAEUSER REAL ESTATE COMPANY has appealed the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner's condition of approval that sewers be required for site plan approval under the P-suffix designation; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council wishes to allow development on the subject property with approved septic tanks as an interim measure pending the availability of sewers; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner has advised the Council that Condition A is no longer necessary,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The reclassification petitioned by WEYERHAEUSER REAL ESTATE COMPANY, designated Building and Land Development File No. 201-76-R is approved for BN-P subject to the conditions recommended by the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner in his report dated February 3, 1976 with the following modifications:


- 1. Eliminate Condition A.


