

MOTION NO. 2670

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the Department of Social and Health Services for funds in the approximate amount of \$80,049 to support Mental Health Special Projects, Grant File No. 654:2.

WHEREAS, the State Department of Social and Health Services is empowered to make grants to support Mental Health Special Projects, and

WHEREAS, the King County Mental Health Plan for 1976 identifies as priorities services to seriously disturbed adults, seriously disturbed youth, and seriously disturbed elderly persons, and

WHEREAS, the Projects proposed for the King County Jail Program, Day Treatment Program for Disturbed Mothers and their Young Children, and Harborview Community Mental Health Center Evaluation Project meet the needs of such youth, adults and elderly persons and can be provided through Special Project Funding, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County supports the priorities assigned by the King County Mental Health Board to the three proposed projects in the order shown above, and

WHEREAS, the funds for Mental Health Special Projects are made available by the state for singular nonrenewable grants, no liability is assumed by King County to provide any additional support to any project, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that provision of such services is in the public interest,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$80,049 to the Department of Social and Health Services, Bureau of Mental Health, on behalf of King County;


1 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed
2 to file and execute such application and contracts as are required

4 3. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into
5 and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
6 implementation of the project;

7 4. The United States of America, and the State of
8 Washington, are hereby assured full compliance with Title IV and
9 Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
