

MOTION NO. 2810

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2 A MOTION expressing Council intent as to  
3 procedures and schedules to be followed  
4 during the development of the East  
5 Sammamish Communities Plan.

6 WHEREAS, preliminary study has been initiated by the Planning  
7 Division on the East Sammamish Communities Plan, and

8 WHEREAS, procedures, responsibilities and schedules have not  
9 been expressly defined, and

10 WHEREAS, a Community Plan when adopted by the County  
11 Council represents the official short range development and  
12 capital improvement program policy for a community, and

13 WHEREAS, a Community Plan provides the link between general  
14 county-wide policies, plans and programs and specific implementa-  
15 tion programs for a community, and

16 WHEREAS, a Community Plan can also be utilized by other  
17 governmental agencies when making decisions concerning community  
18 development;

19 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 (1) The Policy Development Commission shall be responsible  
21 for all community involvement activities for the community plan;  
22 and shall exercise its responsibility through its Community  
23 Development Committee and the community involvement coordinator  
24 assigned to the community plan.

25 (2) A twenty member East Sammamish Communities Plan  
26 Committee shall be appointed for the community plan: ten members  
27 to be appointed by the County Executive and ten members to be  
28 appointed by the Council.

29 (3) The chairman of the East Sammamish Communities Plan  
30 Committee shall be named by the Chairman of the Policy Development  
31 Commission in consultation with the County Executive and the  
32 Council.  
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1           (4) The East Sammamish Communities Plan Committee shall be  
2 thoroughly briefed concerning the scope of the proposed plan,  
3 existing plans and policies applicable to the area, available  
4 funds for the implementation of plan proposals, the relationship  
5 of the committee to the staff, the Policy Development Commission,  
6 and to elected officials, and any other information necessary to  
7 clearly delineate the committee's role and responsibilities.

8           (5) The following schedule for plan development and  
9 completion shall be adhered to:

10           (a) February 28, 1977: Initial community meeting(s)  
11 conducted.

12           (b) May 31, 1977: Preliminary draft plan completed and  
13 presented to the community.

14           (c) September 1, 1977: Final draft plan completed and  
15 transmitted to the Council.

16           (6) The Community Plan Committee shall be responsible for  
17 the development of the East Lake Sammamish Communities Plan.

18           The Planning Division shall prepare proposed policy,  
19 program and map alternatives, and the Committee shall work with  
20 the Department to review and evaluate the proposed alternatives  
21 and propose additional alternatives where needed.

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(7) The scope of the plan shall be principally concerned with areas of utility policies, densities and locations, street and road circulation, and parks. The time frame of the community plan shall be limited to implementation programs planned for initiation during the next ten years.
