MOTION NO. 03320

A MOTION designating Councilman Gary Grant as King County representative to the East and West Side Green River Watershed Projects Advisory Committee, composed of an elected official from each of the sponsoring municipalities.

WHEREAS, King County is the coordinating sponsor of the Green River Flood Control Projects, and

WHEREAS, the cities of Auburn, Kent, Renton and Tukwila, together with the King County Soil Conservation District are co-sponsors, and

WHEREAS, certain deliberations of a political nature beyond the responsibility and authority of technical staff require input from the sponsors in answer to directives and requirements of the Soil Conservation Service, the federal agency undertaking these projects.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Councilman Gary Grant, whose council district encompasses the majority of the project boundaries, is hereby appointed King County Council representative on the East and West Side Green River Watershed Projects Advisory Committee, replacing Councilman Robert E. Gaines. The Advisory Committee includes an elected official from each of the cities of Auburn, Kent, Renton, and Tukwila, as well as a representative from the King County Soil Conservation District. Further, Councilman Grant will report to the King County Council on all matters pertaining to these projects which require Council action.
