MOTION NO. 03325

A MOTION approving the 1978 King County Mental Health Plan and authorizing the Executive to transmit the Plan to the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services.

WHEREAS, the State of Washington, by RCW 71.24, established that the purpose of the Community Mental Health Services Act is to encourage and give financial assistance to local governments in the development of community mental health programs, and

WHEREAS, state law requires that an annual plan for proposed expenditures be submitted to the state in order to establish County eligibility for reimbursement for mental health services provided, and

WHEREAS, the 1978 King County Mental Health Plan has been recommended to the County Council by the King County Mental Health Board;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The attached 1978 King County Mental Health Plan is hereby approved by the King County Council.
2. The Council requests the Executive to submit by March 31, 1978, a report on the statistics gathered at each community mental health center on the number of seriously disturbed persons served during the months of December, January, and February.
3. The Council further requests the Executive to submit by June 30, 1978, a report on the effect that imposition of the

1 funding formula for support of basic programs has had on the
2 community mental health centers. The report should include an
3 analysis of the impact of the formula on each agency's financial
4 ability to offer service within its catchment area and on the
5 types of services being offered to clients.
