A MOTION proclaiming the week of May 21 through May 28 as Rape Relief Week and requesting the County Executive to continue support of Rape Relief programs.

WHEREAS, The King County Council is concerned and recognizes rape as a continuing problem in King County, and

WHEREAS, King County has been supportive of efforts to deal with the problem by previously allocating funds through Revenue Sharing, Special Programs in the King County Budget and through the Executives Contingency Funds, and

WHEREAS, The King County Council has passed an Ordinance on March 14, 1978, to facilitate the correction of this problem in King County by establishing the Women's Program, and

WHEREAS, One of the reasons for establishing the Women's Program was to deal more effectively with the problem of rape in King County, and

WHEREAS, The King County Council recognizes the efforts made to deal with the problem of Rape are in the best interests of all the citizens of King County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The week of May 21 through May 28th is hereby proclaimed 'RAPE RELIEF WEEK' in King County.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED:

The County Executive is hereby requested to continue the promotion of the awareness of the benefits of those programs by those citizens throughout King County in their efforts to help alleviate the problems relating to rape.
