

MOTION NO. 5050

A MOTION sustaining the appeal of Duncan Wallace from the Order of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner remanding the application designated Building and Land Development File No. 172-78-R for the preparation of a threshold determination of environmental significance or non-significance, and directing the Examiner to conduct a public hearing on the application as soon as possible.

BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The application for rezone from F-P (potential G) and G to G, petitioned by DUNCAN WALLACE (formerly L. A. Welcome, et al), designated Building and Land Development Division File No. 172-78-R, is to be considered by the King County Zoning and Subdivision Examiner and the King County Council without revision of the Environmental Checklist dated April 27, 1978 or reconsideration of the threshold determination made by the Manager of the Building and Land Development Division on July 16, 1978 that the proposed development would not constitute a major action significantly affecting the quality of the environment.

The King County Building and Land Development Division of the Department of Planning and Community Development shall proceed as soon as possible to prepare its report and recommendation on the applicant's present proposal, as required by King County Code, Section 20.24.130, and the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner shall schedule a public hearing thereon not less than fourteen nor more than twenty-eight days after the required filing and distribution of the said report.
