2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive
3 to make grant applications for specific
4 solid waste facility capital improvement
5 projects: Duvall Landfill Closure and the
6 fencing, leachate collection extension, and
7 groundwater geology at the Cedar Hills
8 Landfill.

9 WHEREAS, the King County Council by its Ordinance No. 5694,
10 dated September 21, 1981, authorized the issuance and sale of
11 Councilmanic Bonds for various capital projects, including
12 solid waste facility capital projects, and

13 WHEREAS, on November 2, 1981 bids were opened and low bid
14 was accepted for issuance and sale of Councilmanic Bonds for
15 various capital projects, including solid waste facility
16 capital projects, and

17 WHEREAS, grant monies may be available from the Washington
18 State Department of Ecology to help support the cost of the
19 solid waste facility capital projects referred to in Ordinance
20 No. 5694;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 A. The King County Executive is authorized and encouraged
23 to apply for all grant monies available from the Washington
24 State Department of Ecology to help support the cost of solid
25 waste facility capital projects referred to in Ordinance No.
26 5694, and listed below:

- 27 1. Duvall Landfill Closure - Phase II, 1982 C.I.P.
28 Budget Project No. 3067; and
- 29 2. Cedar Hills Development in order to provide
30 fencing, leachate collection extension, and
31 groundwater geology only, 1982 C.I.P. Budget
32 Project No. 3064.

1 B. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to
2 file and execute such applications and enter into and execute
3 such contracts as are required by the grantor.
