

MOTION NO. 6222

A MOTION to set the date for a hearing on the intention of the King County Council to create Road Improvement District No. 99 for street lights in the plat of Twin Lakes Park.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the King County council requesting the creation of a road improvement district for providing electric energy, maintenance and operation to existing ornamental street lights, and

WHEREAS, the director of the department of public works has determined that said petition has been signed by owners of an aggregate amount of the majority of the lineal frontage upon the improvement to be made, and of an aggregate amount of the majority of the area within the limits of the assessment district to be created therefor, and that the improvement appears to be feasible, and that the benefits appear to exceed the cost of the improvement, and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found that said petition is sufficient and that the proposed district is sufficiently developed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

A. It is the intention of the council to establish, pursuant to the aforesaid petition and pursuant to Chapter 36.88 RCW, a road improvement district in King County to be known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 99" (hereinafter "RID 99"). It is intended that RID 99 shall include all the territory described as follows:

In the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 24, Township 21 North, Range 5 East, W.M. Lots 1 through 32 within the Plat of Twin Lakes Park as recorded in Volume 119, pages 61-62 King County plats.

B. It is further the intention of the council to order the improvement of those portions of the following described streets within RID 99 by providing the installation, electric energy, maintenance and operation to street lights:

SW 339th Street and 31st Avenue SW all within the Plat of Twin Lakes Park
Said improvements are hereafter sometimes referred to collectively as the "project".

C. The total cost and expense of the project which is to be borne by all of the property owners within RID 99, is now estimated to be \$25.80 per lot for

1 the first year and \$20.80 per lot for each succeeding year. These costs are
 2 based on a King County office of finance fee of \$5.00 per account to be assessed
 3 the first year, a King County department of public works fee of \$1.50 per
 4 account per year and a Puget Sound Power & Light Company fee of \$8.58 per month
 5 per light. The final amount of said costs and expense to be borne by said
 6 property owners will be determined each year, will be assessed against the
 7 benefited private property within the district, with such assessment levied on
 8 the basis of equal assessment for each platted building lot.

9 D. All persons who wish to object to or to otherwise be heard on
 10 the creation of proposed Road Improvement District No. 99 described herein, on
 11 the accomplishment of the project described herein, or on the assessment of
 12 their property for the cost and expenses of accomplishing the project in the
 13 manner described herein, are hereby notified to appear and present their
 14 objections or testimony at an open public meeting of the King County council to
 15 be held in Room 402 of the King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, at 9:30
 16 a.m. on the 2nd day of April, 1985. At such time and place, the
 17 council intends to hear such objections and testimony and to act on the
 18 intention set forth herein.

19 E. The clerk of the council is hereby authorized and directed to give
 20 notice of said public hearing by publication and by mailing at the times and in
 21 the manner described in RCW 36.88.050.

22 F. The director of the department of public works is hereby directed to
 23 submit to the council at, or prior to, the date fixed for said hearing, a
 24 diagram or print showing thereon the lots, tracts, and parcels of land and other
 25 property which will be specially benefited thereby, and the estimated amount of
 26 the cost and expense of said improvement to be borne by each lot, tract, or
 27 parcel of land or other property, and also designating thereon all property
 28 which is being purchased under contract from the county.

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G. "Costs and expenses of accomplishing the Project", as used herein, shall mean those costs and expenses described in RCW 36.88.300.
