A MOTION authorizing the conveyance of a portion of King County road right-of-way to the State of Washington.

WHEREAS, King County is the record owner of a county road lying within the right-of-way for a state road project (SR 515), and

WHEREAS, in the construction of the aforesaid state road project, it is necessary and advisable for the State of Washington to acquire title to all county road rights-of-way lying within the right-of-way of the aforesaid highway project, and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the council of King County deems it necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County and the State of Washington, that King County convey said county road right-of-way that falls within the aforesaid highway project to the State of Washington by Quitclaim Deed for the consideration of mutual benefits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is authorized to execute, on behalf of the citizens of King County, the necessary instrument in order to convey the following portion of right-of-way and deliver the same to the State of Washington:

SR 515, Junction SR 516 to S.E. 240th Street.
