2 A MOTION authorizing the King County
3 Executive to enter into an interlocal
4 agreement with Washington State
5 University for Cooperative Extension
6 services.

7 WHEREAS, the federal Smith Lever Act, in effect as of
8 October 5, 1962, as well as Washington State Senate Bill No. 73
9 passed in 1949, authorized cooperative extension work to be
10 carried out in cooperation with counties and municipalities, and

11 WHEREAS, King County and Washington State University have
12 provided joint funding for cooperative extension services in
13 King County, and

14 WHEREAS, there has previously been no formal written
15 agreement describing the responsibilities of King County and
16 Washington State University in funding and administering
17 cooperative extension services in King County, and

18 WHEREAS, King County and Washington State University have
19 further defined the roles and responsibilities of each party in
20 providing cooperative extension services through the attached
21 memorandum of agreement, and

22 WHEREAS, this memorandum of agreement provides King County
23 with more fiscal and management control than in the past when
24 the roles and responsibilities of King County and Washington
25 State University were not described in a formal written
26 agreement;

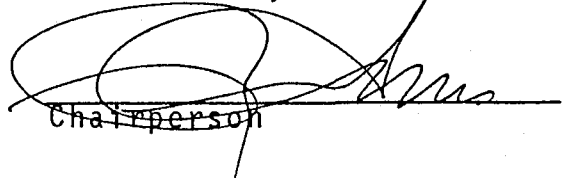
27 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

28 A. The county executive is hereby authorized to enter
29 into an interlocal agreement with Washington State University
30 Cooperative Extension as transmitted on June 5, 1989
31 delineating the funding, hiring, and program planning
32 responsibilities of each party.

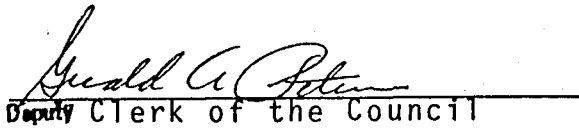
1 B. The Council intends to review effectiveness of the
