3.04.050 Disclosure of income and investments. All elected county officials; employees appointed by the county executive; all employees appointed by the deputy county executive, or department directors, and who are subject to the approval of the county executive; all employees of the council; and such other public employees as may be determined by the board of ethics, shall file with the board of ethics within ten days of employment or appointment and on or before April 15th of each year thereafter a written statement of:

A. All sources of income in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars per year; and

B. The name of any mutual fund or other person or enterprise in which he or she has a direct financial interest in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars; provided, that policies of insurance issued to himself or herself, or spouse, accounts in banks, savings and loan associations or credit unions, are not to be considered financial interest; and

C. Every office or directorship held by the employee, or his or her immediate family in any person or other governmental entity doing business in King County; and

D. A list by legal description or popular address of all real property owned in King County by the employee, or his or her immediate family, including options to buy if the property is valued in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars; and

E. All real property located in King County, divested by the employee or his or her immediate family during the reporting year, the value of which exceeds one thousand five hundred dollars; and

F. With respect to attorneys or others practicing before state and local regulatory agencies during the preceding twelve-month period, the name, the agency or agencies and the name of the person of which the individual is a member, partner or employee and the gross compensation in excess of one thousand five hundred dollars received by the attorney and the person respectively for such practice before such regulatory agency; and

G. All candidates for county elective office as defined in RCW 42.17.020 as amended and nominees for appointment to county boards and commissions, within two weeks of becoming a candidate or nominee, as defined by RCW 42.17.020, and all elected officials, paid in whole or in part by county funds shall file with the division of records and elections a code of ethics financial statement, which includes subsections A. through F. above. These requirements may be satisfied by filing with the division of records and elections a copy of the report required to be filed by RCW 42.17.240 commonly referred to as Form F-1, if this form contains an original signature of the person filing the report. The division of records and elections shall forward a copy of such statements, reports and forms to the board of ethics within 10 days of their receipt.

H. The financing of county election campaigns shall continue to be governed by the provisions of RCW 42.17, and the King County Charter and King County Code. (Ord. 9704 § 6, 1990; Ord. 4808 § 1, 1980; Ord. 2294 § 1, 1975; Ord. 2184 § 2, 1974; Ord. 1308 § 6, 1972).
