2 A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive  
3 to enter into an interlocal cooperation agree-  
4 ment with the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe in order  
5 to implement a low-income housing project funded  
6 with King County Housing Opportunity Funds.

7 WHEREAS, the 1992 King County Comprehensive Housing Affordability  
8 Strategy, adopted by the King County council on October 7, 1991 and approved  
9 by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, identifies  
10 nearly 85,000 low-income households in need of housing assistance and outlines  
11 strategies and housing production goals to address these needs, and

12 WHEREAS, the King County Housing Opportunity Fund was established in  
13 1990 to assist with the development of affordable housing for the county's  
14 homeless, displaced, and special needs groups, and

15 WHEREAS, the proposal by the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe has been selected  
16 for funding with Housing Opportunity Funds in accordance with council-approved  
17 guidelines, and

18 WHEREAS, the interlocal cooperation agreement will regulate the use of  
19 property improved by the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe with funds from the Housing  
20 Opportunity Fund for the useful life of such property, and


WHEREAS, King County and the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe are authorized to enter into such an interlocal cooperation agreement pursuant to RCW 39.34;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The King County executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement substantially in accordance with the terms of Attachment A as amended for this project to reflect the nature of the project and the amount of funding with the Muckleshoot Indian Tribe for a Housing Opportunity Fund project which has been selected in 1992 in accordance with the policies and procedures specified in Ordinance 9369, as amended. This project is: \$150,000 for the improvement of housing for low-income families as risk of displacement.
