King County Arts Commission 1999Special Projects Program Funding Recommendations

1999.500

The King County Arts Commission Special Projects Program convened two independent peer review panels to review applications submitted in compliance with the April 5 1999deadline for project support. Applications were divided between individuals (125 applications) and organizations (175 applications). Three workshops were held to assist individuals and organizations in the preparation of proposals: on March 3, 1999 at the Langston Hughes Cultural Arts Center, on March 3 at Auburn City Hall in South King County, and on March 4, at the Kirkland Performance Center. Many applicants also received assistance via telephone conversations, Internet communication, and office visits. More than 1600 applications were mailed, and the application was available electronically on the Office of Cultural Resources web site.

The applications were reviewed based on criteria published in the 1999 Special Projects Program Application and Guidelines:

- Artistic merit, excellence and innovation of the project
- Feasibility, and applicants ability to accomplish the project
- Appropriateness of overall budget
- Access and public benefit
- Publicity and audience development plans

Panelists were also encouraged to consider the Arts Commission's commitment to geographic diversity, ethnic diversity and cultural diversity.

INDIVIDUALS: The Arts Special Projects Panel reviewing applications from individual artists met first on Wednesday, May 19, 1999, to discuss review strategy, Commission priorities, and funding criteria. The panel met on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, June 9, 10, and 11, 1999, to review 125 work samples (videos, slides, audio, literary excerpts), discuss applications, and make funding recommendations.

King County Arts Commission 1999 King County Performance Network Funding Recommendations

1999 Performance Network: In previous years, the Arts Commission convened panels to review artists for inclusion in the two year pilot program. With the NEA funds exhausted, and a strong desire by the LAA's to continue the program, the Arts Commission set aside \$40,000 for the program. In 1999, the Performance network would be structured in this way:

Local Arts Agencies are responsible for artist selection. A call was issued to artists and arts ensembles in music, dance and theatre to submit work samples and a proposals for the 1999/2000 season. 72 applications were received. The Local Arts Agencies met on March 25, 1999 to review applications, work samples, and make preliminary artist selections.

The Local Arts Agencies proposed -- and the King County Arts Commission agreed -- that the \$40,000 would be divided equally between the 14 suburban arts agencies. \$2,857.14 will be allocated to each local arts agency. Each LAA will apply this amount to artist fees, marketing, promotion and facility expenses. As this amount covers only a fraction of the actual costs of presenting these performances, each LAA is responsible for expenses beyond this allocation. KCAC will provide regional marketing assistance.

ACTION: The King County Arts Commission recommends \$40,000 in funding to the 14 Local Arts Agencies listed above for participation in the 1999/2000 King County Performance Network.
