1 A MOTION authorizing the executive to accept a donation
2 of training manual reproduction services from Worthington
3 Insurance Agency to the King County sheriff's office.

4 WHEREAS, the sheriff's office has a commitment to community policing and to
5 crime prevention, and

6 WHEREAS, public education is an important aspect of community policing and
7 crime prevention, and

8 WHEREAS, the sheriff's office has developed a crime free multi-housing training
9 class designed to educate landlords and property managers in ways to prevent or reduce
10 crime from occurring on their property, and

11 WHEREAS, the sheriff's office established training for managers of multi-
12 housing complexes as a performance measure for the department, and

13 WHEREAS, Worthington Insurance Agency has offered to fund the reproduction
14 of thirty manuals for a crime free multi-housing training class at an estimated cost of
15 three hundred dollars as a public service, and

16 WHEREAS, these manuals would assist in providing public education;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

18 The King County sheriff's office is authorized to accept a donation of thirty copies
19 of a landlord training program manual from Worthington Insurance Agency.


