

ORDINANCE NO. 00009

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners on the 25th day of April, 1969, passed Resolution No. 37159, declaring an emergency which requires an appropriation of money for the 1969 Budget of the King County Council; and

WHEREAS, hearing on said emergency appropriation was set for the 12th day of May, 1969, at the hour of 9:30 a.m. and Resolution and Notice of Hearing published, as provided by law,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by unanimous vote of the County Council of King County, Washington, that an emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made, in addition to the sums provided for in the Budget for 1969, for the purposes hereinafter specified, in the following amounts, to-wit:
