

WHEREAS the County Executive of King County, Washington, has been advised by the Director of the Park Department that due to unforeseen circumstances in the program of the Park Department, it is necessary to request an emergency appropriation under the classification of Salaries and Wages, and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds as a fact that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, to-wit, to preserve cleanliness of parks and aid removal of garbage and preserve life, and for the support of county government and its existing public institutions, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED that the emergency appropriation be granted and that the 1969 Budget of the Park Department be amended as follows:
