

WHEREAS, the County Executive of King County, Washington, has been advised by the Department of Public Safety that there is a need for additional funds to house male inmates in the City of Seattle Jail during the remodeling of the County Jail, it is necessary to request an emergency appropriation under the classification of Operation and Maintenance, from May 1 through December 31, 1969, and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds as a fact that an emergency exists and that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and for the support of County Government and its existing public institutions, now, therefore,


BE IT ORDAINED that the emergency appropriation be granted and that the Budget of the Department of Public Safety be amended as follows:


