Order of Establishment

In the matter of the establishment of the Kerriston-Echo Lake Road
County Road the ~~Board~~ Council finds as follows:

First. That the ~~†~~ Motion No. ~~therefore was~~ * passed on the
14th day of July, 19 69, and the ~~County Engineer~~ Acting Director, Dept. of Public Works was duly directed to
examine and if necessary survey the route of said proposed road.

Second. That on the 28th day of May, 19 69, the Acting Director, Dept. of Public Works of King County ~~Engineer~~ Council filed in the office of the ~~Board~~ his report in writing, and at the same time his field notes and profiles of the proposed road, and a map, as provided by law, and the 14th day of July, 19 69, was set as the day for hearing on said report, and notice of such hearing was duly given by publishing and posting as provided by law.

Third. That the Board, having considered said report and all evidence relative to the establishment of the road, and finding that such proposed road is a public necessity.

COUNCIL
IT IS ORDERED BY THE ~~BOARD~~ COUNCIL, that the Kerriston-Echo Lake Road
Road be established as follows:

Beginning on the centerline of Kerriston Road at a point
N. 77°44'16" W. a distance of 2575.61 ft. from the E. $\frac{1}{4}$
corner of Section 36, Twp. 23 N., R. 7 E., W.M., thence in
a northerly direction a distance of 13,303.94 ft. to a
terminus at STA. 134 + 00 of King County Survey No. 36-23-7-1.
13,303.94 Ft. = 2.52 Miles

Acting Director, Dept. of Public Works
and as shown upon the field notes, profile and map of the ~~County Engineer~~ County Engineer, and that from henceforth
said road shall be a County Road of 60 feet in width exclusive of slopes for cuts
and fills, and that the same be opened according to law.
