

ORDINANCE NO. 00110

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to a County Arts Commission and providing
2 for the establishment of the same, providing for the
3 promulgation of rules relating thereto, and defining
4 the duties and powers of such commission.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL:

6 SECTION 1. There is hereby created an arts commission
7 for King County, Washington to be known as: "King County Arts Com-
8 mission".

9 SECTION 2. The arts commission may alone, or in co-
10 operation with any other private, civic or public body of any
11 city, county or the state of Washington, initiate, sponsor or con-
12 duct programs calculated to further public awareness of and inter-
13 est in the visual and performing arts.

14 SECTION 3. The county arts commission shall consist
15 of twelve (12) members to be appointed by the county executive
16 with the approval of the county council. Such appointive positions
17 shall be for three years respectively. Initial appointments shall
18 consist of four (4) members appointed for a one (1) year term;
19 four (4) members appointed for a two (2) year term and four (4)
20 members appointed for a three (3) year term. Vacancies on the
21 arts commission shall be filled in the same manner as original
22 appointments as described herein; provided further, that one mem-
23 ber of the county council shall be appointed annually to serve as
24 an ex officio member of the arts commission.

25 SECTION 4. The arts commission shall elect its of-
26 ficers, including a chairman, vice-chairman, secretary and such
27 other officers as it may deem necessary. Such persons shall oc-
28 cupy their respective offices for a period of one year. The arts
29 commission shall hold regular public meetings at least monthly.

30 SECTION 5. The arts commission shall adopt rules for
31 transaction of business and shall keep a written record of its

1 proceedings which shall be a public record.

2 SECTION 6. The arts commission shall each year sub-
3 mit to the county executive and county council for approval a
4 proposed budget for the following year in the manner provided by
5 law for the preparation and submission of budgets by appointive
6 county officials.

7 SECTION 7. The arts commission shall establish a fund
8 into which shall be placed the allocation as the county executive
9 and county council shall annually appropriate thereto together with
10 any miscellaneous revenues, grants, gifts or bequests for purposes
11 of furthering the arts. All expenditures shall be disbursed from
12 this fund by the arts commission and all balances remaining in
13 this fund at the end of any year shall be carried over to the suc-
14 ceeding year.

15 SECTION 8. If any provision of this act or the oper-
16 ation of such provision should be held invalid, such invalidity
17 shall not affect other provisions of this act or their operation
18 unless dependent for their effect or operation upon the provision
19 held invalid and then only to the extent of such dependency and
20 for such purpose the provisions of this act are declared to be
21 severable.
