

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

An ordinance relating to re-establishing Flood Control Zone Advisory Committees, defining membership

Be it enacted by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. RCW Chapter 86.15.070 provides permissive authority to counties allowing creation of Flood Control Zone Advisory Committees. There shall be continued by this ordinance Advisory Committees in the following Flood Control Zones:

- Cumberland
- Enumclaw
- Green River
- Greenwater River
- Kimball Creek
- Patterson Creek
- Sikes Creek
- Sikes Lake
- Southwest Lake Sammamish
- West Lake Sammamish

Section 2. Advisory Committees shall consist of five members, appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council, who are residents of the Flood Control Zone Boundary, who shall serve two-year terms or until their successor is appointed and qualified.

Section 3. Members of the Committee shall serve without compensation.

Section 4. Members of Advisory Committees will serve as information assemblers and disceminators in Flood Control Zones and shall be advisory to the Department of Public Works, Utilities and Transportation, its Flood Control Division and the County Environmental Development Commission or its Committees as requested.
