Renton, Washington declaring the same to be a public nuisance and authorizing the 3 summary abatement thereof. 5 WHEREAS, the structures located at 6423 112th Ave S. E. 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ı	Section 2. The owner and any and all persons having
2	any interest in said <u>property</u> is hereby required
3	within Mint (9) days from the effective date of this
4	ordinance to demolish and remove the buildings and adequately
5	cover the well
6	so it no longer constitutes a public nuisance.
7	Section 3. If this ordinance is not complied with in
8	full, as specified in Section 2 above within None (0)
9	days from the effective date of this ordinance, the Director of
10	Public Works of King County or his agent is hereby authorized
11	and directed to summarily abate the same as a public nuisance by
12	summary destruction and removal of the buildings and adequately
. 13	covering the well by such and with such assistance as may be
14	means available to him. The cost of abatement shall constitute a debt
15	to King County and all costs and expenses so incurred shall be
16	and constitute a lien upon said real property upon the recording
17	of a lien notice in the King County Records and Elections
18	Department which lien may be enforced by proceedings provided by
19	law.
