

ORDINANCE  
NO. 954

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to providing bus  
2 transportation services in King County  
3 and amending Section 5 (a), (b), (c),  
4 Section 7, Section 8 and Section 10,  
5 Ordinance 869.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Section 5 (a), Ordinance 869 is amended to read  
8 as follows:

9 (a) The contract shall not exceed ((90)) 120 days and shall  
10 provide for cancellation upon 15 days written notice by  
11 either party.

12 SECTION 2. Section 5 (b), Ordinance 869 is amended to read  
13 as follows:

14 (b) Payment to Metropolitan Transit shall not exceed  
15 \$18,000.00 per month for ((three)) four months or a total of  
16 \$54,000.00. Payments shall be made on the basis of expenses  
17 minus revenues on the Richmond Beach, 15 Avenue Northeast, Bothell,  
18 Renton, and Kent-Auburn routes. ((Fares-on-said-routes-shall-be  
19 deposited-with-the-County-Treasurer.))

20 SECTION 3. Section 5 (c), Ordinance 869 is amended to read  
21 as follows:

22 (c) Metropolitan Transit shall maintain ((its-existing)) an  
23 agreed level((s)) of service on all present routes, including  
24 Richmond Beach, 15 Avenue Northeast, Bothell, Renton, and Kent-  
25 Auburn routes, with the following exceptions: elimination of  
26 Saturday service and rescheduling and alteration of the Richmond  
27 Beach route.

28 SECTION 4. Section 7, Ordinance 869 is amended to read as  
29 follows:

30 Section 7. The County Council hereby creates a special  
31 public transportation committee composed of five Council members  
32 appointed by the Chairman. Such committee shall study and  
analyze the means of maintaining appropriate levels of bus  
transportation service in King County pending development of the

1 Metro system and shall report its findings to the County Council  
2 within ((90)) 120 days.

3 SECTION 5. Section 8, Ordinance 869 is amended to read as  
4 follows:

5 Section 8. The County Executive shall explore the availability  
6 of financial support from other governmental agencies, including  
7 suburban cities and the state and federal government, to share the  
8 cost of maintaining appropriate levels of bus transportation service  
9 in King County pending development of the Metro system and shall  
10 report its findings to the County Council within ((90)) 120 days.

11 SECTION 6. Section 10, Ordinance 869 is amended to read as  
12 follows:

13 Section 10. This ordinance shall terminate on ((September))  
14 October 1, 1971.
