AN ORDINANCE amending King County Resolution No. 34569 wherein the scope of permissible uses of the bond proceeds pursuant to Section 3, paragraph HH of said resolution is made permissive, allowing for the use of said proceeds for any arterial project designated within Resolution 34569.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. Section 3, paragraph HH of Resolution 34569 passed by the Board of King County Commissioners on December 18, 1967, is amended to read as follows:

"The following portion of Bond proceeds to be allocated as set forth in Column 2 in Section 10 under the heading 'Proceeds Allocated to Other Cities,' shall be used and applied consistent with this resolution by Cities other than the City of Seattle for Arterial Highway Facilities which are located within such Cities and which ((shall)) may have been approved by the Urban Arterial Board created pursuant to Chapter 83 Laws of 1967 (Ex. Sess.). The proceeds shall be allocated by the Board among such Cities with the advice of an Urban Arterial Advisory Board to be hereafter created by the Board and to be composed of representatives of the Cities affected."
