

ORDINANCE

NO. 980

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of Ellisport Road (91st Avenue SW to Willard Avenue.)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1: That the Director of the Department of Public Works has made an examination of Ellisport Road along the course and description as set forth below, and has made a favorable report upon same, as required by law.

Section 2: That said road be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning at the West quarter corner of Section 5, Township 22 North, Range 3 East, W.M., King County, Washington; thence S. 00°04'13" W. on the West line of said Section 5, a distance of 1326.45 feet to a concrete survey monument at the intersection of 99th Avenue SW and SW 204th Street; thence N. 89°49'53" E. a distance of 2126.27 feet to the true point of beginning; thence Easterly and Southerly 2580.10 feet to a point of terminus on Willard Avenue at 8th Street, said point of terminus bearing S. 74°45'26" E. a distance of 1073.51 feet from the South quarter corner of Section 5, Township 22 North, Range 3 East, W.M.

2,580.10 feet = 0.489 mile

Section 3: That the King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
