AN ORDINANCE relating to the denial, suspension or revocation of licenses, licensee's right of appeal and repealing Part Second Section 19, Resolution 12402; Section 6, Resolution 12714; Section 8, Resolution 19562; Section 8, Resolution 19563; Section 6, Resolution 23509; Section 8, Resolution 30668; Section 10, Resolution 30983; Sections 18 and 19, Resolution 35143; Section 18, Resolution 36053; Section 15, Resolution 36054; Section 15, Resolution 36055; Sections 14 and 15, Ordinance 00069 and Ordinance 00934.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County License Division shall have the right to suspend or revoke any business license issued upon a showing of violation of the provisions of law under which the license was issued.

SECTION 2. Any person feeling aggrieved by any action authorized by Section 1 of this Ordinance shall have seven (7) days in which to appeal to the Board of Appeals. Where the licensee appeals, the suspension or revocation shall not take effect pending the decision of the Board of Appeals.

SECTION 3. Part Second Section 19, Resolution 12402; Section 6, Resolution 12714; Section 8, Resolution 19562; Section 8, Resolution 19563; Section 6, Resolution 23509; Section 8, Resolution 30668; Section 10, Resolution 30983; Sections 18 and 19, Resolution 35143; Section 18, Resolution 36053; Section 15, Resolution 36054; Section 15, Resolution 36055; Sections 14 and 15, Ordinance 00069 and Ordinance 00934 are each repealed.
