

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to codification of the
2 ordinances and resolutions of King County,
3 amending authority in Title 6; amending
4 Section 4, Resolution 36053 and Section 4,
5 Resolution 36054.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. Any reference to the King County License Director,
8 King County License Department or Board of County Commissioners in
9 Title 6 of the County Code shall hereinafter be amended to read
10 King County License Division.

11 SECTION 2. Section 4, Resolution 36053 is amended to read
12 as follows:

13 All applications for issuance or renewal of a pawnbroker's
14 license shall be made to and be filed with the ((~~county-license~~
15 ~~director~~)) King County License Division on forms furnished ((by
16 him)) for such purpose, and shall be accompanied by the required fee.
17 This application shall state the true name of the applicant, who
18 shall not be less than ((~~twenty-one~~)) eighteen years of age, the
19 names of all persons having a financial, proprietary, or other
20 interest in such pawn shop, together with such other information as
21 the license ((~~director~~)) division deems appropriate. The applica-
22 tion shall then be referred to the King County Sheriff's office for
23 investigation, report and recommendation. If, from the reports and
24 other information available, the ((~~board-of-county-commissioners~~))
25 King County License Division deems the applicant to be a fit and
26 proper person, the ((~~board~~)) division shall issue or renew the
27 license applied for.

28 SECTION 3. Section 4, Resolution 36054 is amended to read as
29 follows:

30 All applications for issuance or renewal of secondhand dealer's
31 license shall be made to and be filed with the King County license
32 ((~~director~~)) division on forms furnished ((by-him)) for such
purpose and shall be accompanied by the required fee. This appli-
cation shall state the true name of the applicant who shall not be

1 less than ((twenty-one)) eighteen years of age, the names of all
 2 persons having a financial, proprietary, or other interest in such
 3 secondhand dealer's shop, together with such other information as
 4 the license ((director)) division deems appropriate. The appli-
 5 cation shall then be referred to the King County sheriff's office
 6 for investigation, report and recommendation. If, from the reports
 7 and other information available, the ((county-council)) King County
 8 License Division deems the applicant to be a fit and proper person,
 9 the ((council)) division shall issue or renew the license applied
 10 for.
