1 AN ORDINANCE acknowledging unanticipated revenue to
2 the Seattle-King County Commission on Alcoholism:
3 appropriating said revenue to the Seattle-King
4 County Commission on Alcoholism for the Alcoholism
Program Evaluation and Improvement Project; and
amending Ordinance No. 639.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 Section 1. The County Council hereby acknowledges the com-
7 mitment of \$24,075.00, from the Washington State Department of
8 Social and Health Services, Health Services Division to the
9 Seattle-King County Commission on Alcoholism for the continua-
10 tion of the Program Evaluation and Improvement Project.

11 Section 2. The Council finds that \$12,037.50, of said funds
12 are available for appropriation for the period July 1, 1971,
13 through December 31, 1971. The remaining \$12,037.50, is avail-
14 able for appropriation for the period January 1, 1972, through
15 June 30, 1972, in addition to any unexpended fund balance as of
16 December 31, 1971.

17 Section 3. The Council finds an additional \$5,373.85, avail-
18 able for appropriation to the Seattle-King County Commission on
19 Alcoholism, which is the balance of a previously separately
20 administered account for the Commission's Evaluation Project.

21 Section 4. A supplemental appropriation in the amount of
22 \$17,411 to the Alcoholism Commission is hereby approved and
23 adopted, provided that said appropriation be utilized for allow-
24 able costs as provided in the agreement between King County and
25 the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services,
26 Division of Health Services for the Alcoholism Program Evalua-
27 tion and Improvement Project.

28 Section 5. Ordinance 639, Section 2, as amended, is hereby
29 amended as follows:

30 Commission on Alcoholism . . . ((\$28,592)) . . . \$46,003.00
