

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the application of WEST SIDE WATER
2 COMPANY for a franchise to lay down, construct, maintain and
operate a water system.

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

4 SECTION 1: The franchise extends along, under, and across County
5 roads, and rights of way existing now and as may be constructed in the future
6 within the area described as follows:

7 (SEE ATTACHED SHEET FOR DESCRIPTION)

8 SECTION 2: King County Ordinance No. 00468, Amendment Ordinance
9 No. 529, and any other applicable County Ordinance must be complied with by
10 the Water District desiring said franchise.

11 SECTION 3: The above matter has come regularly for hearing before
12 the King County Council and it appearing that:

- 13 1. The application was properly made.
- 14 2. The application was referred to the County Executive for
15 investigation of the feasibility thereof and the checking of
16 the plans and description of the location thereof.
- 17 3. The County Executive has made such investigation and has filed
18 with the Council his report and recommendation as follows:
19 For date of hearing
- 20 4. Due and legal notice of said application and of this hearing
21 thereon has been given by posting and publication in the manner
22 and as required by law.

23 SECTION 4: The application of WEST SIDE WATER COMPANY is approved
24 and the franchise is granted as approved. The same shall be executed on
25 behalf of King County by the County Executive.
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EXHIBIT A

The location and nature of the franchise being more particularly described as follows:

On the J.S. Markam Road # 314, commencing at the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between Sec. 25, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M., and Sec. 30, Twp. 23 N., R. 3 E.W.M., thence along the course of said road north $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile, thence West $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile, thence North $\frac{1}{2}$ of a mile.

On the J.J. Simmons Road # 608, commencing at the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between Sec. 25, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M., and Sec. 30, Twp. 23 N., R. 3 E.W.M., thence along the course of said road West 0.8 of a mile.

On that County Road running South from the $\frac{1}{2}$ corner between Sec. 25, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M., and Sec. 30, Twp. 23 N., R. 3 E.W.M., from said $\frac{1}{2}$ corner along the course of said road south $\frac{1}{2}$ of a mile.

On the C.D. Anderson Road in the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M. from its intersection with the J.J. Simmons Road # 608, along the course of said road north and northeast a distance of $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile.

On the G.A. McIntire Road # 857 and on that county road dedicated with the plat of Colvos, known as the Colvos Road, along the course of said roads on the centerline of Sec. 24, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M., from a point 660 feet more or less North of the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between Sec. 24, Twp. 23 N., R. 2, and Sec. 25, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M., to the point where the course of said Colvos road leaves the said centerline, thence along the course of said Colvos road to its intersection with the D.A. Culman Road # 1626.

On all streets, avenues, alleys and public ways in the plats of Colvos, King County, and Vashon Summer Home Tracts.

On the D.A. Culman Road # 1626 from its terminus at a point 542.5 feet more or less East of the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner between Sec. 13, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M. and Section 24, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M., along the course of said road in an Easterly and Northeasterly direction a distance of 2400 feet more or less. The territory to be embraced within this franchise to be as follows:

Gov't Lots 1, 2 and 3, Section 13, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M.; all of Section 24, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M.; the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$; N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ except the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$; and the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ except the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M.; the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 19, Twp. 23 N., R. 2 E.W.M.; the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ and the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Twp. 23 N., R. 3 E.W.M.

The entire tract containing 1380 acres more or less.
