ORDINANCE NO. 1039

AN ORDINANCE relating to the King County Traffic Code as authorized by RCW 46.61.415 and amending King County Resolution No. 36096, as amended by King County Resolution No. 36903, Schedules 1 through 5.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. Pursuant to traffic engineering studies, Schedule 4, which sets maximum speed limit at 40 miles per hour on county roads, is amended to add the following street.

NORTHEAST 160TH STREET, between Juanita-Woodinville Way Northeast and 124th Avenue Northeast.

Section 2. Signs posted to evidence the above described speed limit be installed by the proper authority.
