

SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE
NO. 1050

AN ORDINANCE amending King County Zoning Code Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by amending the Zoning Map thereof reclassifying certain property thereon at the request of

RICHARD C. SHOEMAKER,
Department of Planning File No. 114-70-P.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY

SECTION 1. Richard C. Shoemaker petitioned June 17, 1970 that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from RS 15,000 to M-L and this application was assigned Department of Planning File No. 114-70-P.

SECTION 2. The report and recommendation of the Department of Planning was transmitted to the Zoning & Subdivision Examiner July 28, 1970 and hearing was held by the Examiner on this matter September 22, 1970. The attached report of the Examiner was filed with the Clerk of the King County Council October 7, 1970.

SECTION 3. The legal description of the property hereby reclassified is attached as Appendix A and is hereby made a part of this ordinance. The above described property is shown on the attached map, designated as Appendix B and is hereby made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. The King County Council does hereby amend King County Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying that property described and shown in Section 3, Appendices A and B above, to M-L and directs that Area Map No. E&W 27-26-5 be modified to so designate.
