AN ORDINANCE relating to and regulating the design, construction, equipping, operation, and maintenance of spray and wading pools, public and semi-public swimming pools; requiring plans and permits; establishing safety, water quality and sanitation standards; establishing a Swimming Pool Advisory Committee; defining offenses and providing penalties and amending Section 5 A, Ordinance 451.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Section 5 A, Ordinance 451 is amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to open for use, or allow or cause to be used any public or semi-public swimming pool for swimming or bathing purposes without having a current, valid permit to operate issued by the Director of Public Health. Application for such permit accompanied by an annual fee of Seventy-five (\$75.00) shall be made in writing to the Director of Public Health on a form to be provided by him; provided that the fee for any initial permit to operate shall be prorated on the basis of onetwelfth the annual fee for each remaining month in the year and provided that in any subsequent calendar year that a permit is required by the terms of this ordinance and the public or semipublic swimming pool is operated for less than six (6) months of the calendar year, the permit fee shall be thirty-seven dollars and fifty cents (\$37.50). The Director of Public Health shall inspect the proposed public or semi-public swimming pool and upon determination that such swimming pool complies with applicable rules and regulations and the provisions of this ordinance shall issue a permit to operate to such applicant. Permits to operate shall expire on December 31 of the year for which issued and shall be renewable upon like application and payment of the annual fee.
